***Report on Feedback for Online Classes for Even Semester***  
***(January-June 2021)***

***Objective:***

The objective of the feedback collected from the students at the end of the even semester, was:

- a) To get an estimation of the students who could avail to the online classes.
- b) To understand the difficulties that the students encountered during the online classes.
- c) To find means and ways to make the online classes interesting for the students- How can we (the teachers) make the classes more interactive? How can we ensure student participation at a time when we are so distant from our classroom space?
- d) To recognize areas where we can make improvements in our teaching methods and apply that to the online classes next semester.

***Mode of Feedback:***

The feedback was conducted via google form, where the students had to answer a set of 15 questions. Some of the questions were objective (Yes/No) while in some questions students had to type out their suggestion/experience.

The questionnaire was completely anonymous in order to get the most honest answer from the students regarding their experience with the online classes as well as the performance of each and every teacher in the department during the given semester.

***Participation***

The questionnaire was filled by the Honours students of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Semester of the English Department. The google form link was shared with the respective batches (three separate forms for each batch), and those who were inclined towards giving their feedback, participated in it.

***Responses***

### 1. Were you able to avail online classes?

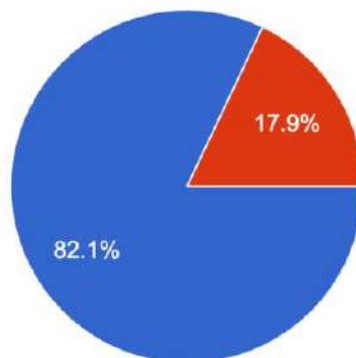

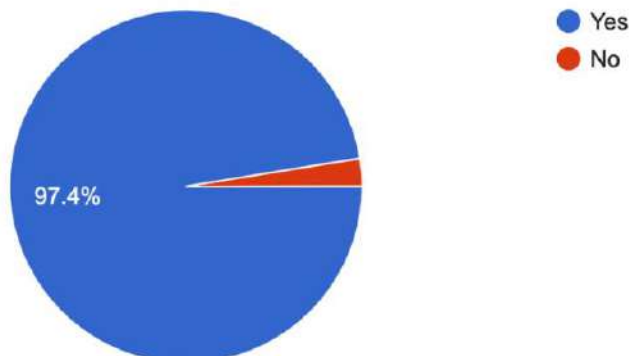
### 3. If Yes/No, please mention why?

- It's not like that the teachers are bad or something I just don't like the method of teaching online I believe that I can focus more when the classes will be held on college offline

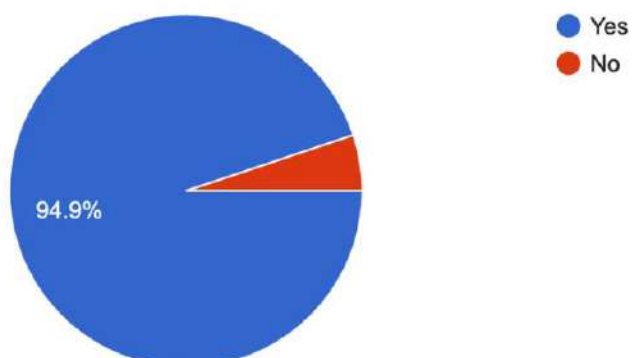

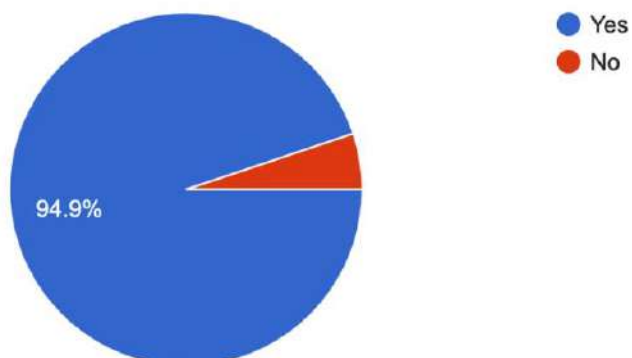
5. Were the class timings suitable for you?

- Most of the syllabus is completed.

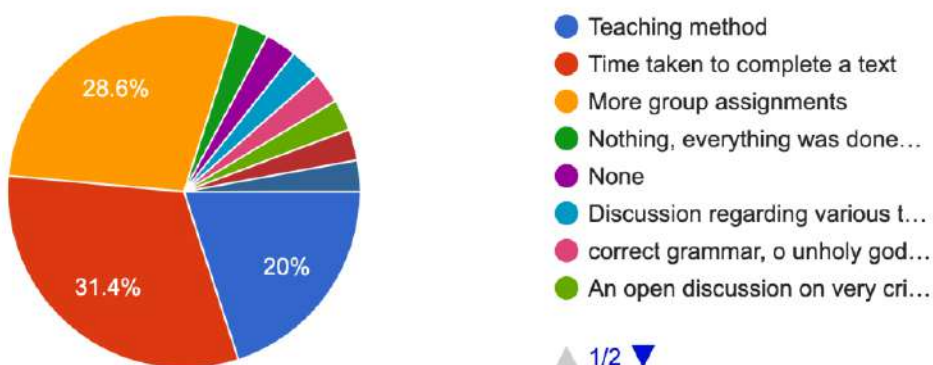

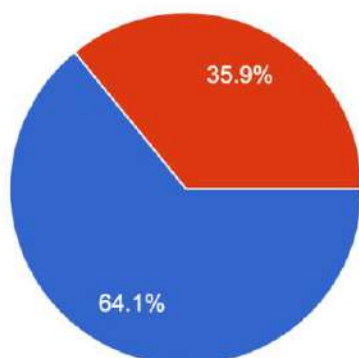
9. Given a chance, what is one change that you would like to see in the future online classes?

### 10. Do you have supportive classmates?

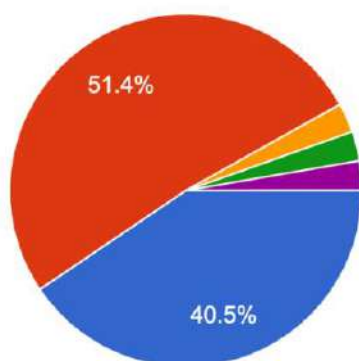

### 11. What motivates you to learn more?

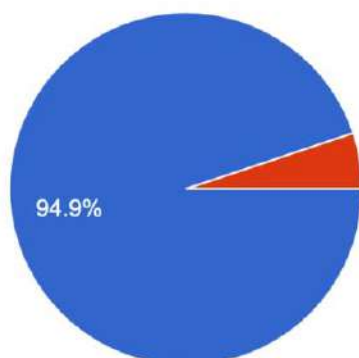

- No, not at all

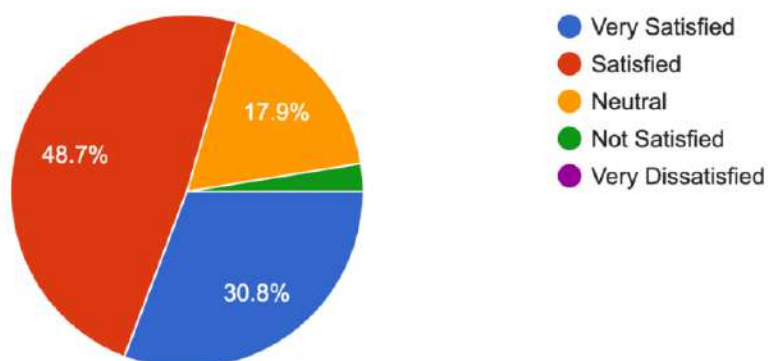
13. What extracurricular activities can the department organise to further your learning?

- Our department has already been holding up seminars, dramas etc. I would really appreciate if it continues in the next semesters.

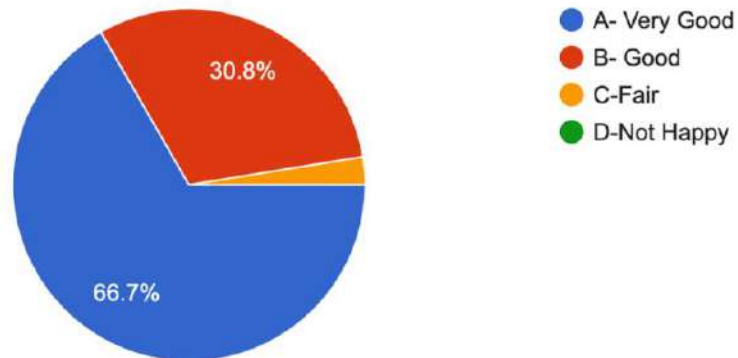

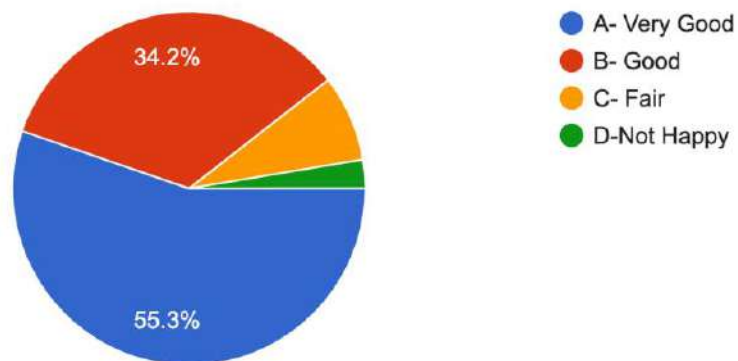
15. How would you grade the classes of Rajdeep Mondal (RM)?

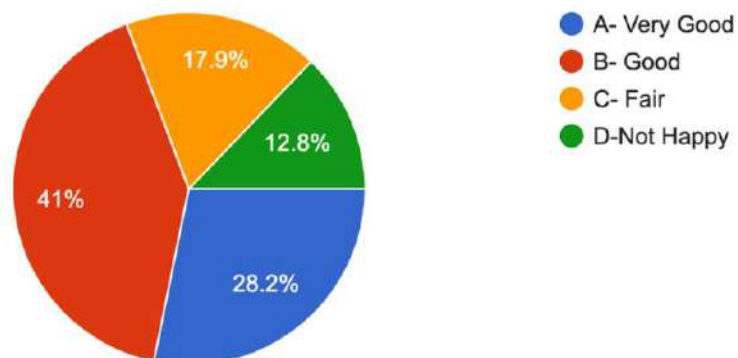
16. How would you grade the classes of Somnath Bhattacharya (SB)?

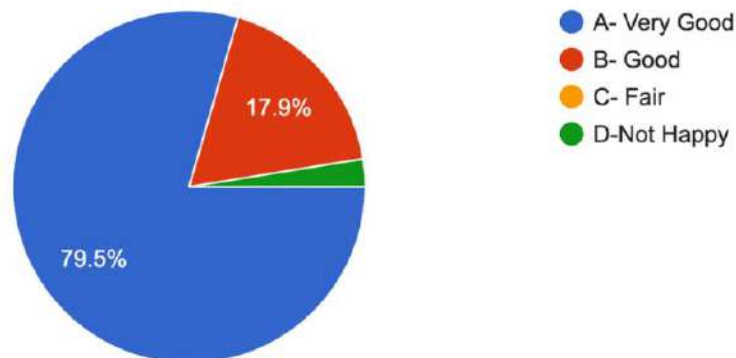
17. How would you grade the classes of Kakoli Sengupta (KS)?

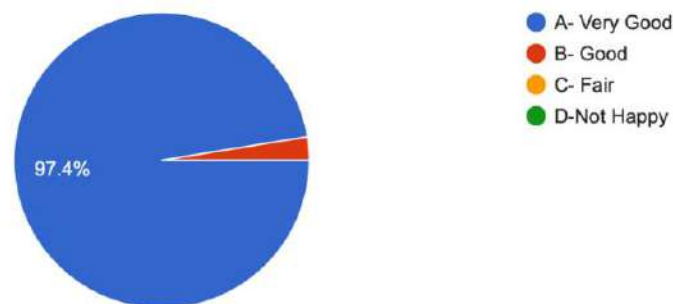

- If teachers organize more role plays, seminars, group assignments , solo assignments on several topics related to our syllabus will be really helpful for us to learn more about that topic.

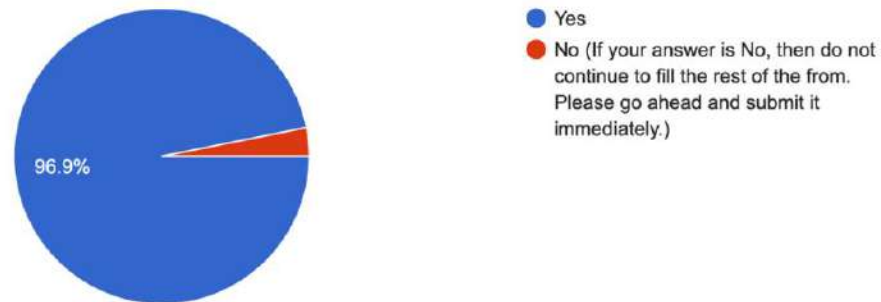


## Semester 4 Response

32 students from Semester 4 responded to the feedback questionnaire. Their responses to the questions asked are as follows:

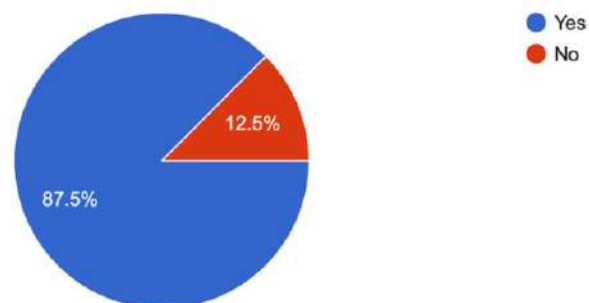
1. Were you able to avail online classes?

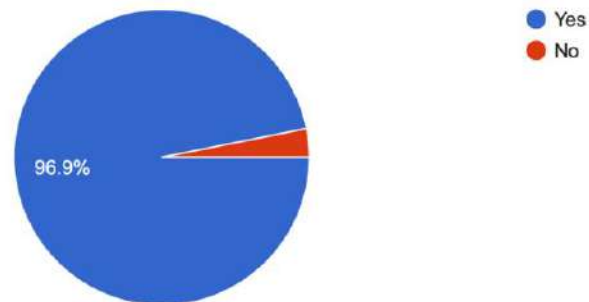
3. If Yes/No, please mention why?

- Not satisfied though the teaching part was satisfying but because of the problem in communication, network issues, lack of direct interaction with professors , etc

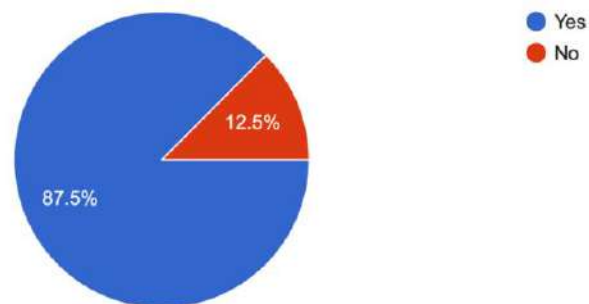

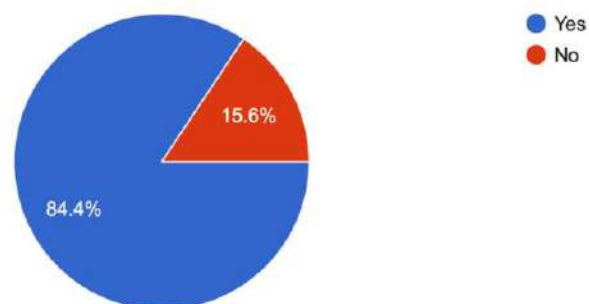
5. Were the class timings suitable for you?

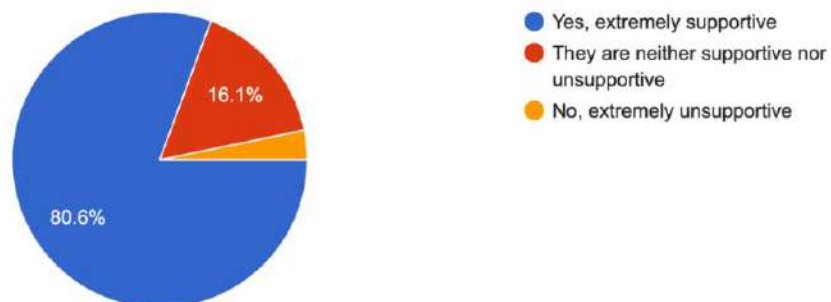

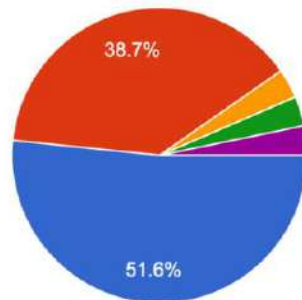

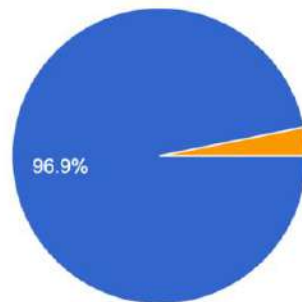

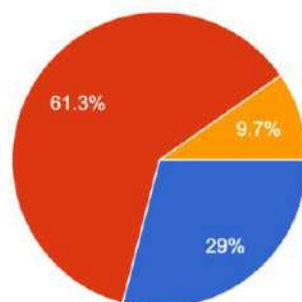
13. What extracurricular activities can the department organise to further your learning?

14. How would you evaluate the overall academic experience you had this semester?

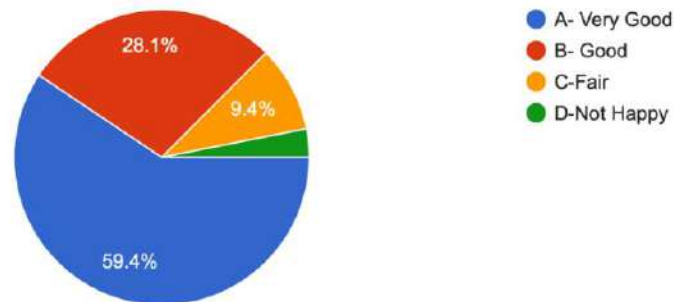

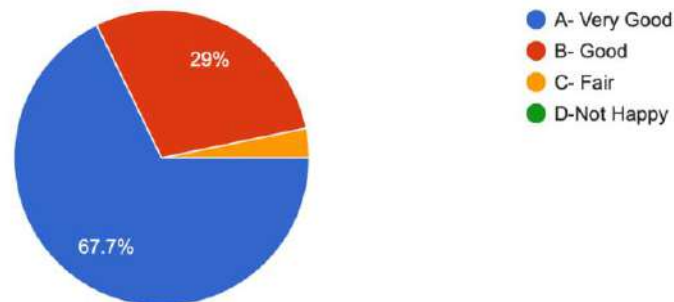
15. How would you grade the classes of Rajdeep Mondal (RM)?

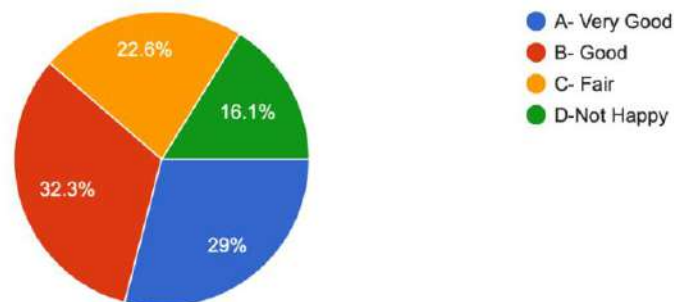
16. How would you grade the classes of Somnath Bhattacharya (SB)?

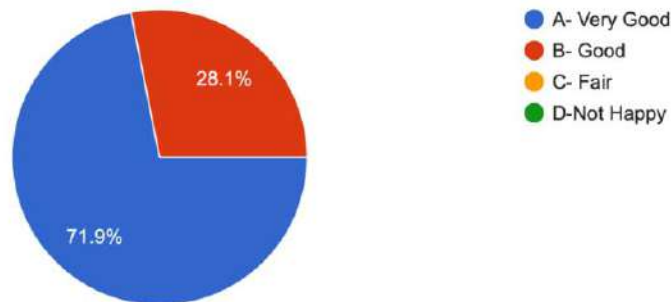
17. How would you grade the classes of Kakoli Sengupta (KS)?

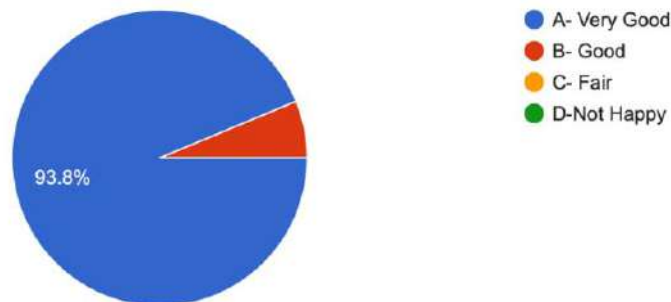
18. How would you grade the classes of Rinjee Lama (RL)?

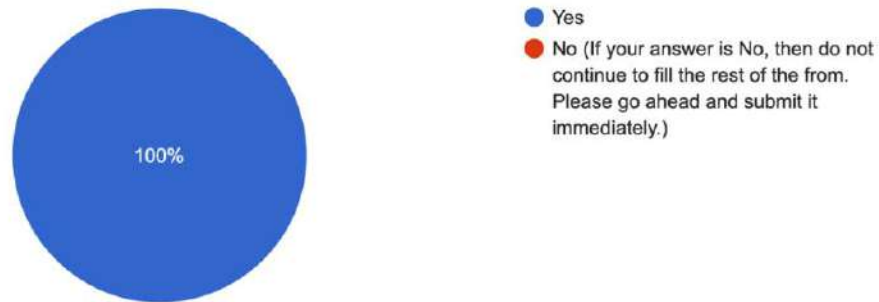
- More notes should get posted in Google Classroom ,because in this pandemic time we are unable to purchase book by visiting a bookstore.

29 students from Semester 6 responded to the feedback questionnaire. Their responses to the questions asked are as follows:

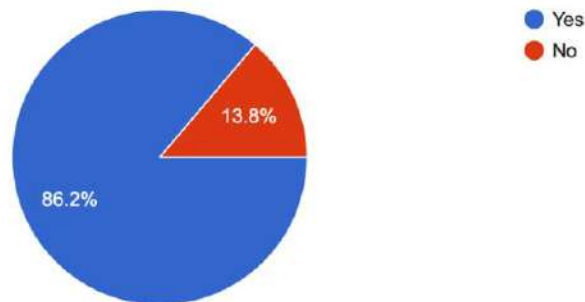
1. Were you able to avail online classes?

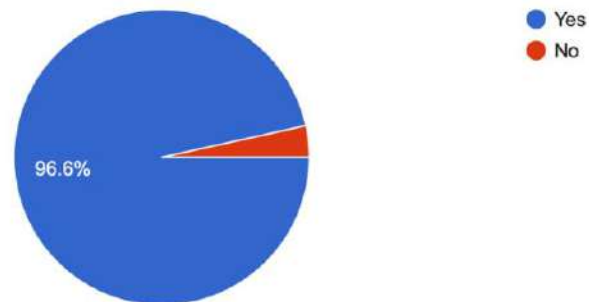
3. If Yes/No, please mention why?

- Offline mode is better

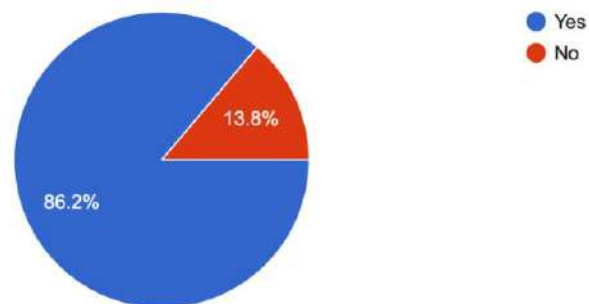

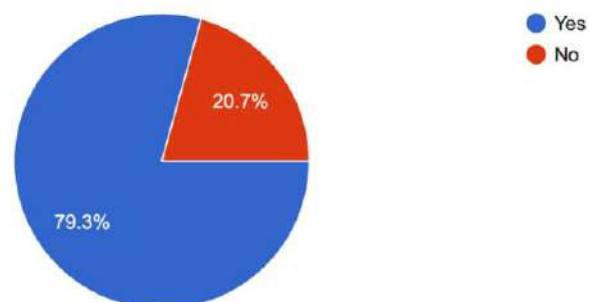
5. Were the class timings suitable for you?

7. If answer to Question 6 is No, how much percentage of syllabus is yet to be completed?

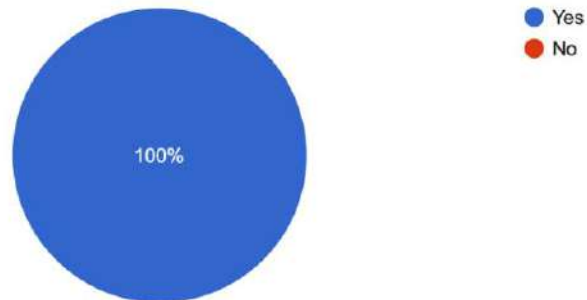
Student responses:

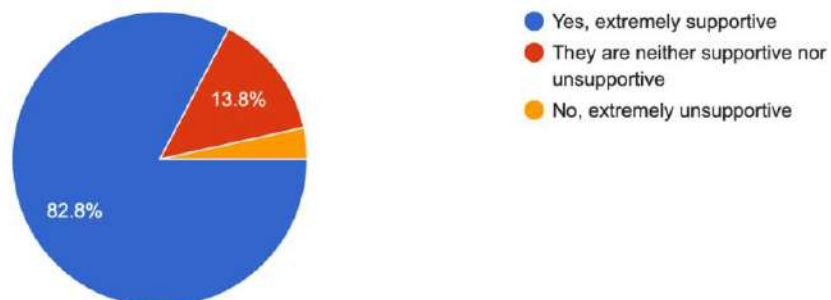

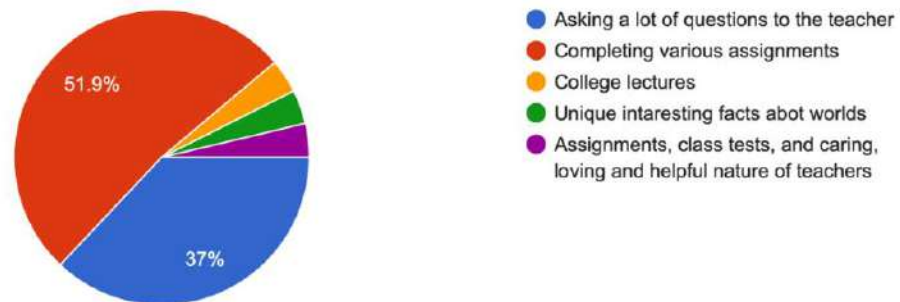

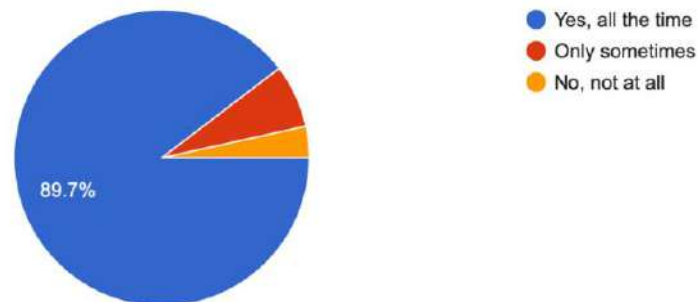

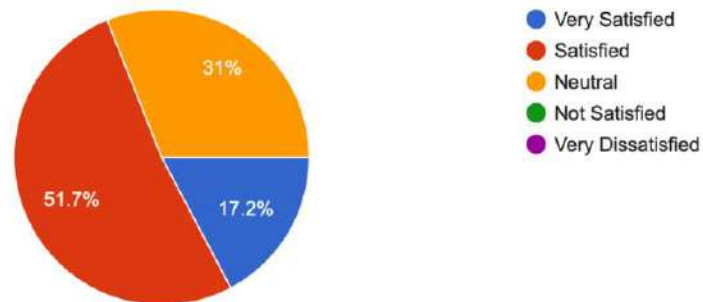

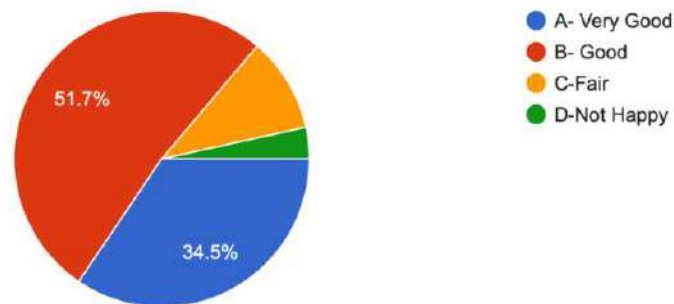
14. How would you evaluate the overall academic experience you had this semester?

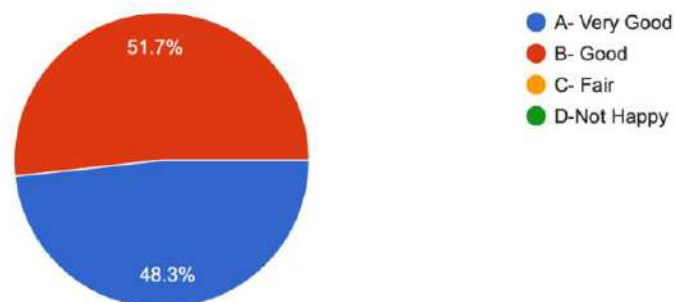
15. How would you grade the classes of Rajdeep Mondal (RM)?

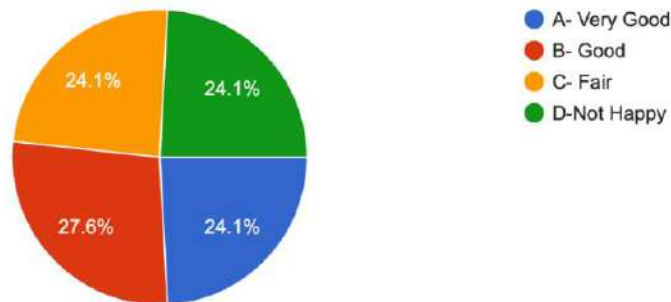
16. How would you grade the classes of Somnath Bhattacharya (SB)?

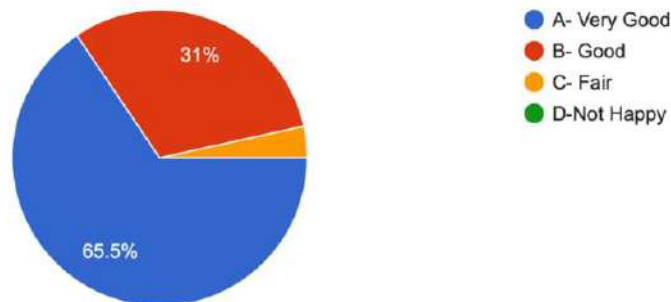
17. How would you grade the classes of Kakoli Sengupta (KS)?

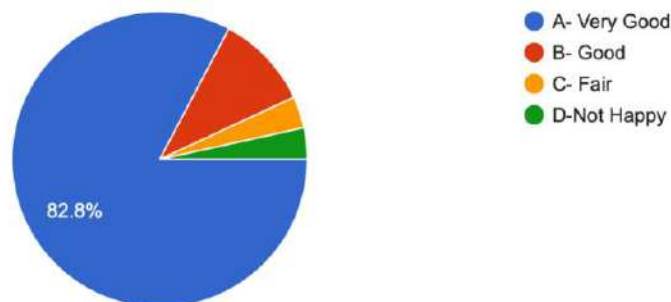
18. How would you grade the classes of Rinjee Lama (RL)?
