Outcome of Session 1 Dr. Deepa Duraiswamy, from the very beginning, did set the tone of the webinar where the students were encouraged to dream, to aspire for something, to carve out their worlds. In the words of A. P. J. Abdul Kalam, "Dreams transform into thoughts and thoughts result into actions." She, while, quoting from Dickens' Tale of Two Cities, motivated the students and guided them how to make most out of this time. Dr. Deepa addressed the heterogeneous crowd by focusing on the sectors that would generate employability in the long run in the present context, the skills that they need to acquire to make themselves employable, the ideas of Social Entrepreneurship by sharing real life examples. She inspired the creativity in the students and urged them to create something on their own, whatever it might be. The session was, indeed, interactive in which she took up the questions from the students. Like she gave the idea to the students from the Mathematics department that the whole world of Data Science are open for them to explore. **Outcome of Session 2** Mr. Bijoy Dutta chose a way in which every student could relate herself/himself with his journey since his college days to building a career on his own. He was primarily focusing on the career prospects of the students from the commerce discipline, the professional they courses that may simultaneously with their under graduate and post graduate courses. He also gave the current scenario of the BFSI sector and in what ways, in what job roles, the sector may generate employment in the long run. The session was also followed by an interactive discussion in which students clarified their doubts regarding the acceptability recognition of the various professional courses in the corporate set up.
